This week, Dosbarth 10 have been celebrating Respecting Other's Week. We kicked off the week by wearing Odd Socks to celebrate our uniqueness. The theme for this year is 'Make a Noise About Bullying', which reminds us of the importance of talking about bullying and not staying silent if we see, hear or experience bullying.



Dosbarth 10 have discussed what bullying is, types of bullying, how to deal with bullying and what to do if they see, hear or experience bullying. We also discussed what effects bullying has. We looked at different scenarios and discussed the reasons behind the bullying and how to deal with it. We created anti-bullying posters and worked collaboratively to think where to go for help, how to react and any good deeds we could do to help and the kind words we can share to improve others' wellbeing.
